Brian works 40 hours per week. 30 hours are spent doing regular building cleaning during the evening and 10 hours per week are spent during the day, at the office, doing various office tasks and computer-related work at an additional \$2.00/hr.

April has been an employee for 4 years. Her base rate is higher due to seniority.

She has a full-time job with another company and also works 10 hours per week at Bear Cleaners. She works Sunday morning for 4 hours using a company vehicle, and Monday evening for 6 hours using her own vehicle with mileage paid. As well, she was paid a \$20.00 bonus for the construction clean-up job.

Mark attends university as well as working for Bear Cleaners for over a year. Between semesters, he works 30-40 hours per week, while attending school, he works 15-20 hours. He does regular building cleaning with a team member, as well as post-construction cleanup which gives him an extra \$1 an hour, and carpet cleaning which pays him an extra \$2 an hour. Mark received a \$30 bonus for some carpet jobs.

Brent does carpet cleaning, upholstery cleaning, and floor stripping and waxing. Because of his skillset, his base rate is higher.

This gives him an extra \$2.00 an hour for each job, along with an additional bonus for certain jobs. As well as the jobs listed, Brent also does regular business cleaning when needed. After cleaning a customer's carpets and upholstery, he was given a bonus for each job.

- ❖ Employees gaining seniority within the company will see the opportunity to discuss pay rate increases. (Some examples were shown above)
